Estimated Costs of Study at Binghamton On a Tuition, Fees, and Housing Exchange an Undergraduate Student 2024-2025

Binghamton University provides for full-time student tuition (12 or more credit hours), a stand double room in the residence halls, and semester billable fees.

Exchange students are required to show proof of financial resources equivalent to \$6775 for one semester, or \$13,550 for the academic year, on the State University of New York Foreign Student Financial Statement.

Food and Housing

Costs vary for housing and meal plans according to selection. The exchange program covers the cost of housing in a standard double room in the residential colleges. A student may choose a more expensive housing option (such as a room in an apartment community such as Hillside or Susquehanna Community must pay the additional costs. Meal plans are not required for students who are housed in Susqueh Hillside Apartment Communities, prices listed are for a standard (level C) meal plan for the 2023-202 academic year plus 5% to account for the potential of rates rising.

Students who are 22 years old or older may not live in the residential colleges. They may live in the Hillside or Susquehanna Apartment Communities. On-campus room and board options and conceptained on the Residential Life and Dining Services web sites: http://reslife.binghamton.edu and http://budining.com. Students on the "Tuition, Fees and Housing Exchange" may not live off campus

Many students opt to travel on weekends and breaks. The cost of travel and alternative housing during breaks is not factored into this estimate of costs and should be considered by the student when determ budget for personal expenses.

Health Insurance

The SUNY health insurance fee was \$214 per month for 2023-2024. Insurance rates have risen considue to COVID-19. The costs given are the 2023-24 rate +5% estimated increase for 2024-25. The c for the insurance will appear on your semester bill.

Fees

Fees covered by the exchange program include the regular semester billable fees. Some courses have laboratory, equipment, activities, or supplies fee, which is the responsibility of the student. The New Fee is a one-time charge applied to every student and will be charged to your student account bill. It the cost of the mandatory orientation. The International Student Fee is charged to each international st each semester and covers the cost of administering the SEVIS immigration requirements at Binghamt

Orientation

In addition to the Exchange welcome and orientation activitites, <u>incoming exchange students are requattend the International Student and New Student Orientations</u>, held by the office of International Stuc Scholar Services and Student Affairs. The new student fee is \$220 for all incoming undergraduate exstudents.
